

From the Superintendent

Happy Holidays! I am happy to announce that Mr. Ken Olsen has begun his new position as the School Resource Officer for Laurens Central School. He will be a valuable member of our staff and school safety committees and has already been an attendee at multiple after school activities. We introduced Mr. Olsen to our students and staff via individual classroom visits for elementary grades and an assembly for grades 7-12. Since he has relatives at LCS and has already spent some time here as a teacher aide I have no doubt that his transition into his new role will be seamless.

We hope you have the opportunity to attend some upcoming basketball games. We will have our own boys' and girls modified and boys' JV teams; we are merged with Milford for boys' varsity, girls' varsity and girls JV basketball. Our Pat Grasso Girls' Holiday Tournament will be held on December 5, 6 and 7. The Boys' Grasso Tournament will be held on January 2, 3 and 4 with our annual Athletic Hall of Fame inductions on Friday, January 3. We are also hoping to provide a merged Laurens/Milford indoor track and field team for our student athletes this winter.

At this time we are still awaiting the report from the Rockefeller Institute of Government regarding state education aid. The recommendations in this report will be delivered to Governor Hochul on December 1, prior to the release of her initial state budget proposal. These recommendations and the Governor's subsequent actions could have major implications for education funding for small rural districts like ours, so we are eagerly awaiting the release of the report as we start to plan the 2025-2026 budget.

The New York State Education Department has also released its preliminary timeline for the implementation of its new "Portrait of a Graduate" and its plan for reimagining education in New York State. According to the recently released timeline it is anticipated that this year's sophomore class will be the last class that will be required to pass Regents exams to meet graduation requirements. As we receive more specifics we will distribute them to our families and the public.

As always, thank you for your continued support of our students and programs. I wish you all a very happy holiday season and look forward to great things happening at LCS in 2025.
