At the request of the Otsego and Schoharie County Departments of Health, all public schools in Otsego and Schoharie County will be closed for two weeks, beginning on Monday, March 16th. This decision was made out of an abundance of caution, in hopes to slow the spread of COVID-19 in our area.

In anticipation of closure, our teachers have worked on developing educational packets to ensure that your children have the tools they will need to stay on track with their coursework during this time.

On Monday, March 16th, our faculty will be completing all of their educational packets. High School teachers, in addition to paperwork, will also be putting course information up on Microsoft Office 365 for those able to access the internet. Please know that not being able to access the internet will not be a problem for those with limited devices and/or internet service. Teacher have given great thought to this and have prepared hard copies of required work for all students.

On Tuesday, March 17th, we will be asking all parents to stop at the main office to pick up your student's work packet. If you cannot do so during the school day, please call the main office on Monday to make other arrangements to get the work for your child.

After the two weeks, the Public Health Department will make the determination if the two weeks have been sufficient or if more time is needed. This is an ever-changing situation, and we are grateful for your patience as we work through the logistics of this.
